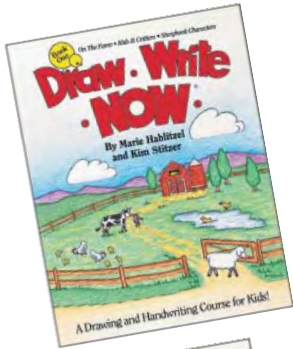

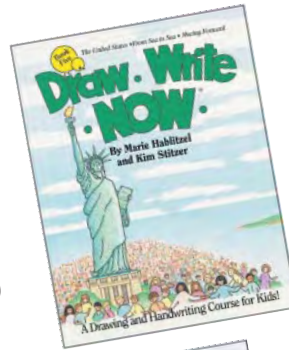
BOOK 1

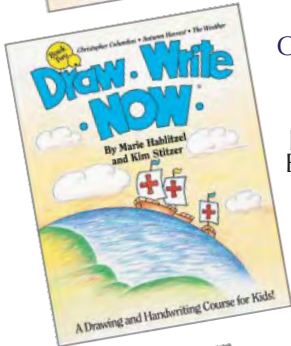
BOOK 5

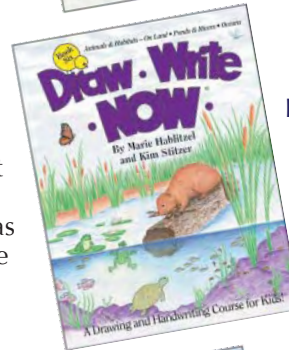
BOOK 2

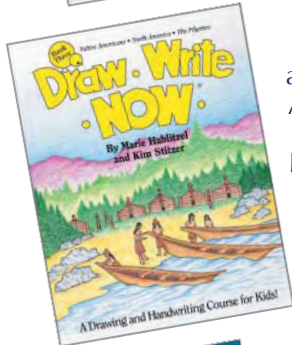
BOOK 6

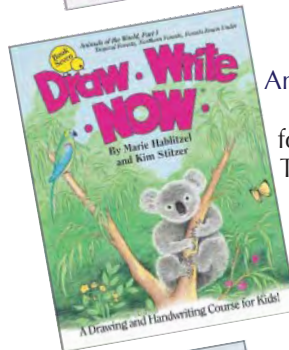
BOOK 3

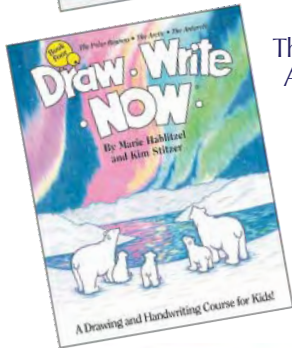
BOOK 7

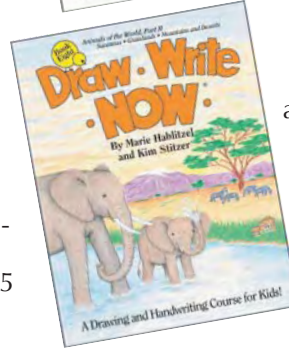
BOOK 4

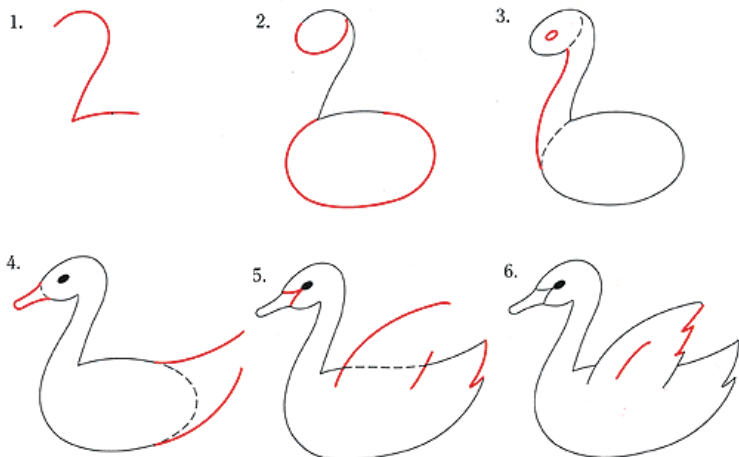

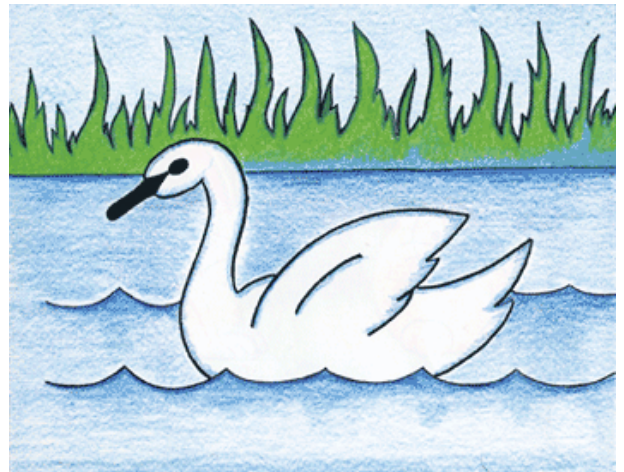

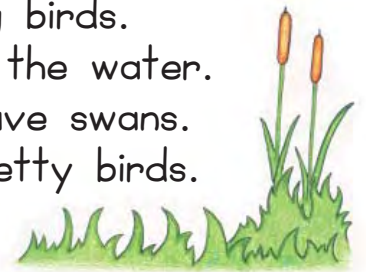

Speak, Write, Handwriting — The short sentences prompt written or spoken stories or are copied for handwriting practice (any handwriting style).

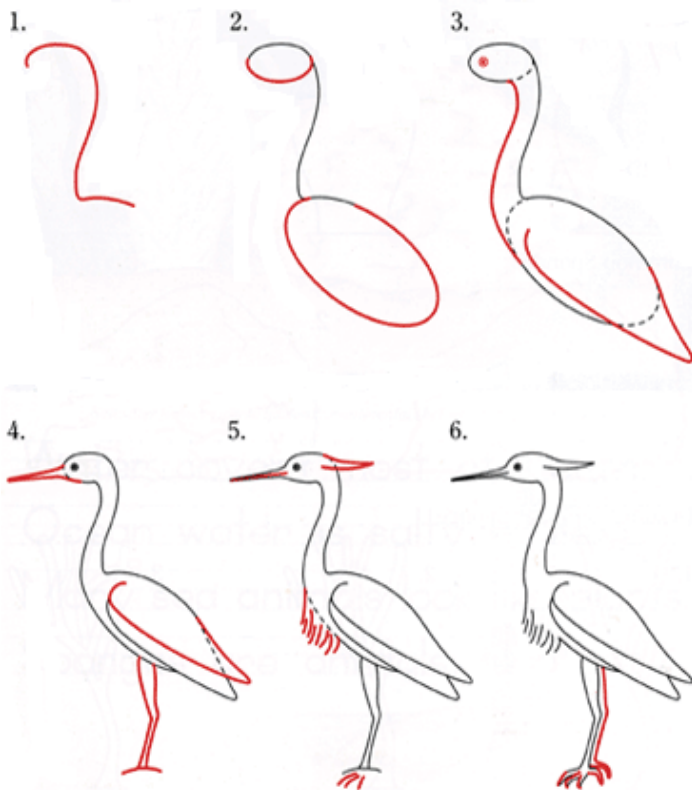


Swans are big birds.
